POSITION DESCRIPTION:

- Engaging Private donors through in-person and online communication and marketing efforts
- Developing fundraising campaigns to be used in a variety of mediums
- Working with the Director of Marketing to administer direct fundraising campaigns on the ITBC website
- Working with ITBC staff to develop targeted campaigns with corporations in order to secure both funding and resources in support of Tribal buffalo programs
- Liaison on specific NGO relationships, including, but not limited to, overseeing fundraising activities related to the ITBC/TNC Letter of Engagement, and all strategic planning related to developing these partnerships.
- Collaborate with the Board of Directors to create and implement a fundraising plan
- Maintain relationships with existing sponsors and build future sponsor relationships
- Manage fundraising and special events
- Generate development materials in concert with other ITBC staff such as grants and case statements
- Utilize fundraising software to track progress
- Travel will be required at up to 50% of the time
- Other duties as assigned.
